

Rotary's Rally for the Record Poker Run Participation Card

This is NOT a race! It is a run, please stay safe and enjoy the ride...and of course Poker. All players must register their completed cards at Recreation Park, Tomah, where they will be dealt their hand and draw cards. Sheet collection will be Saturday, Sept 18 from 4:00-7:00PM. Winners will be announced at 7:15 at Rec Park.

\$10 per hand, there are NO limits on how many hands you can draw.

- a. Only one card needs to be stamped per rider, extra cards can be purchased at the time of hand drawing.
- b. Sheets will be at each designated location listed below.
- c. Players can start at any location desired.

Game will be played as 5 card draw.

- a. Each stop is worth one card (Minimum 5 stops)
- b. Players will receive one card after their hand is recorded, in case there is a tie to determine the winner.

Payouts will be 60% of the purse. The other 40% will go to support Tomah Rotary Club projects.

Players DO NOT have to be present to receive any winnings.

Poker Hand Rankings (highest to lowest)

Royal Flush

Run of sequential cards from Ten to Ace, with all cards of the same suit.

Straight Flush

Run of sequential cards, all cards in the same suit, but not Ace high.

Four of a Kind

Four cards of the same rank, e.g. four Aces, four Kings, etc.

Full House

Three cards of the same rank plus a pair, e.g. three Aces and a pair of Kings

Flush

Five cards all of the same suit

Straight (Run)

Five sequential cards, not of the same suit.

Three of a Kind

Three cards of the same rank, e.g. three Aces, three Kings, etc.

Two Pair

Two sets of pairs, e.g. a pair of Aces and a pair of Kings, etc.

Pair

Two cards of the same rank, e.g. two Aces, two Kings, etc

High Card

If you have none of the above, then the highest value card in your hand plays.
